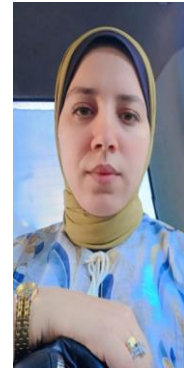

Teaching characteristics & Methods I Use in My University Teaching

- Set goals
- Be prepared
- Don't lecture directly from the textbook
- Write key points on the board briefly
- Encourage students to participate in class
- Use visual aids, videotapes, overheads, and films
- Use real-world examples (Use concrete examples)
- Discuss current research findings in class
- Be fair with all students
- Be available for students
- Use different teaching strategies such as Lecture, cooperative learning, flipped classroom, group discussion, and gamification.

Personal characteristics & Technologies Used (examples)

1. Be punctual for class (Be prompt for class)
2. Vary teaching methods (Vary class formats)
3. Review previous day's lecture at the beginning
4. Encourage cooperative learning
5. Be relaxed and occasionally humorous.
6. Utilize modern IT in teaching (Use E-Learning in the classroom)
7. Maintain eye contact with students
8. Do not embarrass students (Don't embarrass students by publicly calling on them)
9. Vary voice levels
10. Speak slowly and clearly
11. Move around actively
12. Base grading on various factors
